Sylvan Rupp, 86 years of South Toledo, passed away peacefully in his sleep at the Ohio Veteran's Home in Sandusky, OH on October 16, 2009, after succumbing to Alzheimer's/Dementia. Sylvan worked as a Diesel Mechanic Supervisor for Signal Delivery Service in Findlay, OH, retiring in December 1986. He and Marietta moved back to Toledo after he retired.
