



Teresa Ankley Langenderfer

June 17, 1913 - January 22, 2016

Teresa Langenderfer, 102 years of Toledo, Ohio, passed away on Friday January 22, 2016 at Hospice of Northwest Ohio inpatient Center in Toledo. Teresa was born on June 17, 1913 to Elmer and Kathryn Martin Ankley in Burnside Township Michigan.

Teresa graduated from St. Catherine's High School, Detroit, MI, on June 17, 1930 and attended the Detroit Business Institute. She was employed at Butler Paper Company, Detroit, MI, from 1931 to 1941 and in the Chicago sales office of the Fraser Paper, LTD., Madawaska, Maine, from 1941 to 1946.

Teresa married Gilbert J. Langenderfer, formerly of Swanton Ohio, on August 26, 1944 at Holy Name Cathedral in Chicago. She was a member of Our Lady of Perpetual Help Altar Society and parent council at St. Francis de Sales High School Mother's Chapios Society. She was an active volunteer in all three organizations for several years; as well as, in the women's division of the United Appeal from 1954-1974.

She was an avid bridge player beginning in high school until 2004. She joined the American Contract Bridge league in 1978 and was an active duplicate player in tournaments and local ACBL games until 2004. She earned the status of Life Master in June 1996 and earned 935 master points in 2004.

Teresa bowled from 1956-1974 in the Heatherdowns CC Women's Bowling League and she was a member of Christ the King Church since 1977.

Teresa was preceded in death by her husband, Gilbert Langenderfer; her parents; son, Dean; brother, Matthew Ankley and sister, Marcella Groff. She is

survived by her son, Dale Langenderfer, Toledo, OH; grandchildren, Benjamin, Geoffrey, Natalie, Jonah (Amy) Langenderfer; sisters, Marie Drouillard, Dearborn, MI and Margaret McDonald, Farmington Hills, MI.
