Theresa "Tisa" Lyn Pacella, 51, died peacefully in her sleep on October 1 at her home in Loveland, Ohio.

Tisa was born on September 24, 1970 in Dayton Ohio. She spent her childhood days in South Toledo, where she was a member of St Patrick of Heatherdowns Parish. Most of her time was spent at Laurel Hill, swimming and excelling at tennis. Tisa was part of a state championship team at Notre Dame Academy and she continued her tennis career at Bowling Green State University. At one point in time, Tisa held the BG record for most career doubles wins.

Her job took her all over the United States - Florida, Minnesota, North Carolina and back to Ohio. She also worked in London for a year where she had time to visit several European countries.

Tisa's greatest love was her family. She was always in contact with her "out of town" family - parents, sisters, aunts, uncles and cousins. Tisa loved her telephone visits. Her niece Libby and nephew Charlie held a very special place in her heart. She was incredibly proud to be called "aunt".

Tisa is survived by her parents Pat and Diane , sisters Kim and Heidi, brother-in-law Andy Temming, niece Libby Temming, nephew Charlie Temming, God

parents Jim Dineen and Patti Mikolay, and aunts, uncles, cousins and friends.

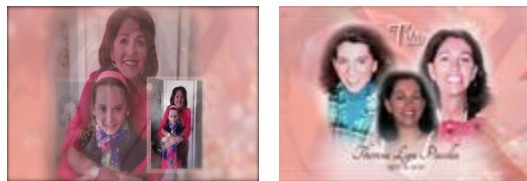

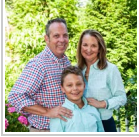
