Thomas C. Rotterdam, 58 years of Maumee, passed away Sunday May 3, 2009.

In the Spring of 1969, Tom was in the first graduating class of St. John's Jesuit High School. He went on to receive a Bachelor's degree in Political Science at the University of Toledo.

Through the years Tom worked in retail management starting with the Lane Drug Company and managing several other stores during his career.

Surviving are his son, Joseph Rotterdam (fianc?, Sara Whaley), daughter, Laura Rotterdam, mother, Ann Rotterdam and sister, Carol Ebdon. He was preceded in death by his father, Jerry and his brother, Jim.

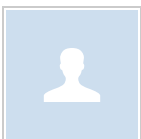
