Virginia E. (Pohlman) Langenderfer, 87, of Maumee, Ohio died Monday, July 21, 2008 in Hospice of Northwest Ohio, Toledo.

Virginia was born in Toledo, Ohio to Ida and Henry Pohlman. One of eleven children, she attended Walbridge Elementary and Libbey High Schools.

She was a homemaker, but also was a longtime friend of the Wixey family, owners of Toledo's Wixey Bakery. In the 1970's, the friendship led to a part-time job at the bakery and eventually she worked at the bakery for over 30 years, retiring in 2006.

Virginia was an enthusiastic bowler, enjoying the sport for nearly 50 years. She most recently bowled in a league at Timbers Bowling Lanes until her ill health prevented her from continuing in 2006. She also enjoyed reading, cross-stitch, and in her later years, traveling. After the death of her husband, Charles W., in 1997, Virginia traveled with her family to many places she had wanted to see, including the Grand Canyon, the Rocky Mountains, the Grand Tetons and Yellowstone National Parks, New York, and San Francisco. She even fulfilled a longtime desire to take a hot air balloon ride over northwest

Ohio.

Virginia was married 52 years. Besides her husband, she also was preceded in death by her nine brothers and sisters. She is survived by daughters, Cheri (Timothy) Barnes and Sandra (Jonathan) Chavez; grandchildren, Scott Barnes, Kelly (Donald) Hershberger, and Dana Chavez; great-grandchildren, Alyssa and Jessica Barnes; her brother, Roland Pohlman, and many nieces and nephews.
