Richard Lee Weber, passed away February 6, 2011, at the age of 48. Loving son of John and Marie (Gaynor) Weber; dear brother of Jerry Weber and Jackie (Weber) Bonfield; beloved companion of Kara Stover and uncle of John P. Weber, Madeline Bonfield and Alliea Bonfield.

Survived by many aunts, uncles, cousins, friends and rescued animals. A 1981 graduate of Bowsher High School, Rick worked for many years at Miller's Schwinn in Maumee and was known for his exceptional mechanical skills. In 1985 he enlisted in the Army, was stationed at Ft. Carson, CO, and Baumholder, Germany. While in Europe, he enjoyed traveling, but was troubled by the experience of visiting a Nazi concentration camp. Rick took pride in his

military service and was promoted to Sergeant (E-5) in April 1987. His duties included being the Company Commander's driver and radio operator at Ft. Carson, and the Battalion

Commander's driver in Germany. He received a special commendation for driving 100,000 miles breakdown-free. Rick would spend hours tinkering with mechanical objects and antiques to bring them back to life. He could rebuild a car engine or craft a beautiful stained glass kaleidoscope. He always sought perfection in his work.
